

Inlet, NY "TO DO LIST"



During the Spring, Summer or Fall (Winter also for some)...

- Hike a mountain: Rocky, Black Bear, Bald (fire tower), Wakely (fire tower), Stillwater (fire tower) Blue (fire tower) or West
- Hike to a waterfall at Cascade Lake or West Pond both near Eagle Bay/Big Moose or Death Brook near Raquette Lake
- Explore some virgin White Pines towering 150 feet in the air at Cathedral Pines between Inlet & Raquette Lake
- Walk out onto a bog to explore the plants and maybe get a glimpse of boreal birds at Ferd's Bog in Inlet off Uncas Road
- See the loons, ospreys and other birds around Moss Lake near Eagle Bay/Big Moose off Big Moose Road
- Fish for bass, pike, trout or pan fish on the Moose River or the Fulton Chain of Lakes
- Go for a swim at a free public beach (lifeguards on duty) at Inlet's Arrowhead Park or Old Forge Beach
- Play tennis on the public courts at Inlet's Arrowhead Park or Old Forge Lakefront
- Play pickle ball on public courts at Inlet's Fern Park Pavilion or Inlet's Arrowhead Park or Old Forge Lakefront
- *Enjoy a book, video, newspaper, or check your e-mail at the Inlet Public Library or Old Forge Library or Raquette Lake Library
- Set up camp at one of the many camping areas: Free Camping: Moose River Recreation Area, Moss Lake or
DEC Paid Camping: Alger Island, Browns Tract Pond, Eighth Lake, Golden Beach, Limekiln Lake, Nicks Lake or
at a Private Campground: Old Forge Camping Resort, HTR Adirondacks Campground
- *Ride the rails on the Adirondack Scenic Railroad in Thendara (scenic excursions and special event trips)
- Pedal through part of an Adirondack forest on a rail bike at the Adirondack Scenic Railroad in Thendara
- Enjoy NY State's largest water theme park at the Enchanted Forest/Water Safari in Old Forge
- Play miniature golf in Inlet: Putterfingers (temporarily closed) or in Old Forge: Nutty Putty or
 Calypso's Cove (which also has a zip line, go carts & arcade)
- Rent a mountain bike in Inlet: Pedals & Petals or in Old Forge: Mountainman and explore the many trails in the area
- ~~Go horseback riding with Adirondack Saddle Tours in Inlet on Uncas Road~~
- Go llama trekking with Moose River Farms in Old Forge on Rondaxe Road
- Rent a canoe, kayak or SUP in Inlet: Frisky Otter Tours or Inlet Marina, in Eagle Bay: Palmer Point,
in Old Forge: Rivett's Marine, Mountainman or Woodcraft to take to any of the many lakes within the Adirondack Park streams
- Rent a pontoon boat in Inlet: Inlet Marina, or 4th Lake Rentals (Stiefvater's), in Big Moose: Dunn's Boat Service,
in Eagle Bay: Palmer Point or in Old Forge: Rivett's Marine, in Raquette Lake: Burke's Marina
- Rent a motorboat or fishing boat in Big Moose: Dunn's Boat Service, in Eagle Bay: Palmer Point or
in Old Forge: Rivett's Marine, in Raquette Lake: Burke's Marina
- Rent a sailboat from Palmer Point in Eagle Bay Rent a Sea-Doo Switch from Daikers in Old Forge
- Book an activity (Tubing, Wake Surfing, Water Skiing, Swimming, Sightseeing, Sunset Cruise) on Fourth Lake with Minnows Adventure
- Book a trip on the Moose River with Mountainman
- Take a chairlift ride and see the whitetail deer and an awesome view at McCauley Mountain Ski Area
- *Visit View Arts Center in Old Forge to view the ever changing exhibits on display or take part in one of their activities or workshops
- Play on a playground in Inlet: Arrowhead Park, Fern Park or in Old Forge: George T Hildebrant Recreation Center, Old Forge Beach
- *Cruise Adirondack lakes aboard Raquette Lake Navigation, Dunn's Boat Tours, Stillwater/Beaver River Noridgewock Adirondack
Wilderness Cruise or Blue Mountain Lake Boat Livery, Inc.
- *Take a narrated dinner cruise aboard the W. W. Durant of Raquette Lake Navigation
- *Visit the Inlet Historical Society or the Town of Webb Historical Association exhibits
- *Enjoy watching first run films on the four screens at The Strand Theatre in Old Forge
- Play 9 holes of golf at the Inlet Golf Club or play 18 holes at the Thendara Golf Club
- *Learn about the early Adirondack logging industry at the Northern Logger's Exhibit Hall & Museum in Old Forge
- *Take a ride to Adirondack Experience, the museum on Blue Mountain Lake
- *Tour an Adirondack Great Camp at Great Camp Sagamore in Raquette Lake
- Get a bird's eye view of the Adirondacks aboard a seaplane at Payne's Air Service in Inlet or Bird's Boat Livery in Raquette Lake
- Take a guided canoe or kayak tour with Frisky Otter Tours in Inlet
- *Hit the unique shops, restaurants and pubs along, and just off, Route 28 from Thendara to Blue Mountain Lake

During the Winter Only...

- Rent skis in Inlet at Pedals & Petals and ski groomed trails at Fern Park in Inlet,
or McCauley Mountain in Old Forge, or the Thendara Golf Club
- Rent snowshoes in Inlet: Pedals & Petals, in Old Forge: Mountainman and explore the snowy Adirondack forest
- Rent skates in Inlet at Pedals & Petals and go ice skating at the Fern Park Pavilion in Inlet or at the outdoor rink in Old Forge
- Ice fish on the Fulton Chain of Lakes, Limekiln Lake or Raquette Lake
- Go sledding at Fern Park in Inlet (Little Free Sled Library) or at McCauley Mountain in Old Forge
- Rent skis and downhill ski at McCauley Mountain Ski Area in Old Forge
- Rent snowmobiles in Old Forge: Adirondack Mountain Sports Snowmobile Rental, ADK Snowmobile Outfitters or RPM
